- Please enclose all relevant documents substantiating your claim as a person of Indian origin. (Please also see Cols. 14 and 15).
- Please enclose a self-addressed and prepaid envelop for mailing back PIO card.
- Applicants must provide original and copy of landing paper.
- Applications for **children born to Indian parents in Canada** must be accompanied by (i) the child's Canadian passport, (ii) original birth certificate mentioning the names of the parents and (iii) both parent's Indian passport, PR Cards, Landing Papers, Citizenship Certificates and copies of all these documents.
- Attach 4 recent photographs (35 mm X 35 mm) showing full frontal view of the face.
- Fees: For adults : C\$ 480/-; children below 18 years of age: C\$ 240/-.
- Please enclose your current foreign passport, Indian passport (expired or otherwise), PR Card, Landing paper, Citizenship Certificate and copies of the relevant pages of these documents.

- A Child should affix left hand thumb impression – right hand in case of female and left in case of male (INSIDE THE BOX). Whereas in the place of “Signature of the applicant”, the parent will have to sign. Note: Where children can sign, they should do so in the box.
- Processing time is one week in normal cases. For mail-in applications it is **15 WORKING DAYS**. It may take longer in certain cases requiring reference to authorities in India or elsewhere.
- Furnishing of false information will result in summary rejection of the application.
- Note : Acceptance of application form does not confer any right on the applicant to the PIO Card.
